<code>Titanium.Analytics.optedOut</code>	property	Allows the user to opt out from Analytics during runtime to comply to GDPR. (New API, supported on Android, iPhone, iPad and Windows Phone.)
<code>Titanium.Analytics.setOptedOut</code>	method	Sets the value of the <code>Titanium.Analytics.optedOut</code> property. (New API, supported on Android, iPhone, iPad and Windows Phone.)
